If you want to be part of an innovative solution to poverty built on relationships and become friends with someone whom you might otherwise not meet...there are two main ways to do this (check the box(es) which you are willing to commit to, or would like to understand more about):

**Become an Ally to a Circle Leader:** Allies provide support and advice to a Circle Leader (an individual working to lift themselves out of poverty). An Ally commits to 4 - 10 hours a month and attends meetings twice per month for a period of 18-24 months.

**Work in a specific resource area:**

- Fundraising
- Communications and public outreach
- Community support - helping at monthly meetings by cooking, serving, being a friend, assisting with the children's program
- Ad Hoc Ally – subject matter experts (e.g., finance or interview techniques) that assist Circle Leaders and Allies with specific skills or information
- Participating in meetings to help resolve local and systemic issues that keep people in poverty
- Building relationships with local business and education leaders to identify opportunities for Circle Leaders
