This event was attended by about 25 members. GHTC Van transportation was provided. Van transportation was also provided to Hollywood Cemetery for a guided tour on June 20. This very enlightening walking tour was led by an excellent guide from the Valentine Museum. The tour was concluded with a picnic lunch on the grounds with box lunches from Sally Bell's. The tour and lunch was attended by 10 members.

Service Activities

In response to a request from Elaine Quinn who has been the GHTC representative on the committee that organized the 2017 Sumer Camp on the Hill, the Boomers committee took on the task of helping to recruit camp counselors, missionaries and van drivers for the three-week camp held in July and August. Members of the committee also collected new board games for the campers to use at the camp and books that were given to the campers. Boomers collaborated with the camp director to develop the bus routes for the GHTC van for pick-up and drop-off of the campers for each of the three weeks. Members of the Boomers committee served as van drivers and navigators.
