## ABOUT THE CHAPEL ORGAN

The new Allen Historique IIG Chapel Organ was given to the glory of God and in loving memory of Alan Gregory Saunders by his wife, Cathy Saunders, honoring their marriage in this chapel on November 19<sup>th</sup>, 1977.

The new Allen organ has 34 stops and nine complete stop lists including English Cathedral, Cavaillé-Coll which is well suited for French music, and Arp Schnitger which is well suited for Bach and other baroque music. It also contains many additional stops such as chimes, harpsichord, grand piano, carillon, and solo stops such as trumpet, oboe, english horn, french horn, and clarinet. The tuba and festival trumpet stops will work well for wedding processionals, recessionals, and fanfares for the bride's entrance. This lovely Chapel Organ will be a blessing to our worship and music ministry at Grace & Holy Trinity Church.




